LAB WRITE-UP FORMAT

All Lab Write-Ups should be word processed (preferred) or *legibly* hand written.

Title Page

Include the name of the lab, your name, and the date.

Introduction

This should be approximately $\frac{1}{2}$ page stating the purpose and application of the lab to the current topic being studied.

Materials

List all materials used in the laboratory procedure.

Procedure

This may be a brief summary of the procedure and should refer the reader to the proper handout or lab manual (including page numbers and using proper citation) for a detailed procedure. Please avoid the use of "I", "we", "my lab partner", etc. while writing this portion.

Data/Analysis/Observations

This section is worth the most credit and should include:
Any required sketches or pictures which have been labeled in detail, thoughtful observations, answers to assigned analysis questions posed in the lab procedure, and any worksheets which may accompany the lab. Any pictures from the internet need to be properly cited. Credit will not be given for pre-labeled pictures found on the internet or shared with other lab students.

Conclusions

This should also be at least $\frac{1}{2}$ page, and should relate the purpose to the data and observations in the lab and include any new or useful insights learned by completing the laboratory procedure. Please avoid the use of "I", "we", "my lab partner", etc. while writing this portion.

Bibliography

Cite all sources which were used as a reference for *any* of the above sections: citing the source of the laboratory procedure; answering questions, labeling sketches/pictures; and writing a thoughtful "Introduction" and "Conclusion".
