I. CLASSROOM RULES

1. **BE PREPARED FOR CLASS EACH DAY.** Please bring your BOOK, PEN (black or blue ink only), or a sharpened pencil, science NOTEBOOK, and any other materials which are requested.

You **will not** be allowed to leave the room to go to your locker, get a drink, or use the restroom.

2. **BE ON TIME.** If **you are** not in your seat when the bell rings, you are **TARDY**. Turn in all assignments on time, No Late Work. All assignments are due at the beginning of class.

3. **RESPECT. Respect** the rights and properties of others.

Respect the teacher and other students by raising your hand and not using profanity.

Show **respect** by listening quietly when the teacher or another student is speaking to the class.

Respect the property of others by obtaining permission to use any thing that belongs to the teacher, the school, or another student.

4. **NOT IN CLASS - NO** makeup or grooming.

NO food, drink, candy, or gum.

NO passes given for restroom, lockers, or drinking fountain.

NO electronic devices (beepers, cell phones, games, CD or MP3 players and HEADPHONES).

5. **DO NOT LEAVE YOUR SEAT** without permission.

6. **THE BELL DOES NOT DISMISS YOU, THE TEACHER DOES.**

II. HOMEWORK

1. May be assigned every day as necessary.

2. **NO LATE WORK** will be accepted. All homework assignments are due at the **BEGINNING** of class, anything after is LATE and cannot be turned in. If you are **TARDY** – your **homework is LATE** and will count as a O.

3. There is **NO EXTRA CREDIT**.

4. **MAKE UP WORK** is for verified absences only (*parents/guardians must supply proper verification to the teacher*). NOTE: You have 1 day per absence to make up any missing assignments.

III. NOTEBOOKS

1. You are required to keep a **separate notebook for Science. It should be a 3 ring (1 ½ inch rings or larger) binder which holds 8 1/2" x 11" notebook paper. This notebook will be checked periodically for a grade.**

2. **This rules letter and an assignment sheet should be kept in the front of the notebook.**

IV. LABS

Labs must be made up within **ONE WEEK** from a verified absence, otherwise they will become a **ZERO**. If the equipment and materials are no longer available then you will not be able to make up the lab.

V. QUIZZES AND TESTS

1. Must be made up with in **ONE WEEK** of the absence, otherwise they will become a **ZERO**. If you are absent on the day prior to a test or quiz, **you will still take the test or quiz on the day it is given.**

2. A **cumulative** Final Exam will be given and count for approximately 15% of your grade.

V. GRADING

1. **COURSE GRADES** are based upon the number of points earned out of a total number of points possible. Letter grades are calculated from a percentage of the total points possible and the following scale is used:

90 - 100% = A

80 - 89% = B

70 - 79% = C

60 - 69% = D

Below 60% = Fail

2. **CITIZENSHIP** - You will be evaluated daily on your performance during lectures, tests, and labs, and the number of completed assignments which you turn in. Be prepared for class and **BE ON TIME** (including turning in work, remember, there is No Late Work).

NOTE: 3 unexcused tardies will result in a "U" in Citizenship. Your parent or guardian will be notified.

3. **EFFORT** - Your Effort grade is also based upon your ability to conduct yourself in the classroom according to the rules (See: Classroom Rules #3-6) and completed assignments.

NOTE: 4 unexcused tardies results in a "U" in Effort in addition to the "U" in Citizenship, and a referral for the current quarter.
